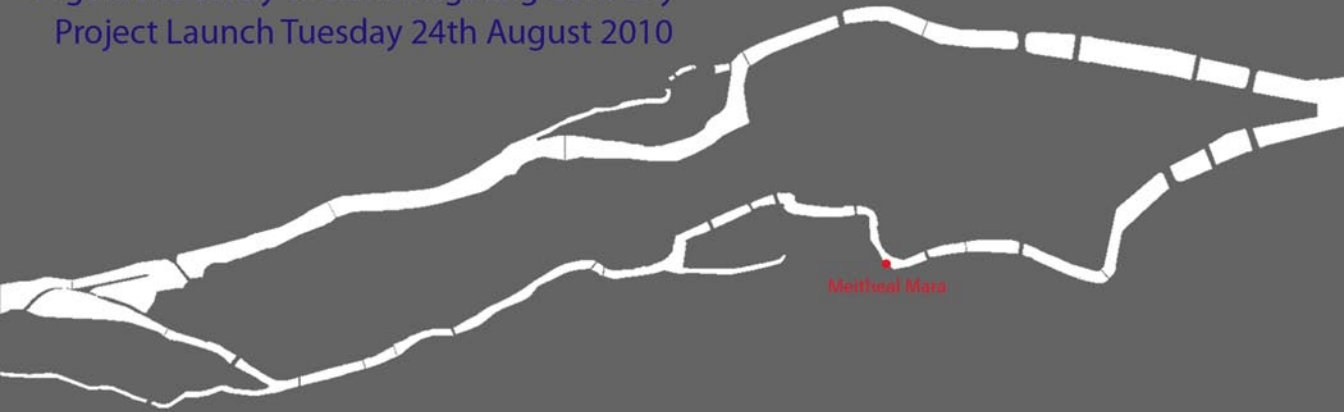


CORKUMNAVIGATION

A guide to safely circumnavigating Cork City
Project Launch Tuesday 24th August 2010



CORKUMNAVIGATION is a project sponsored by the Heritage Council and carried out by Meitheal Mara and the CCAE (Cork Centre for Architectural Education). It is the production of a map and navigational notes for assistance to those wishing to experience the natural, physical, maritime and built environment of Cork city from the river. As well as benefitting those going afloat on the river the guide will also help others to a greater understanding of the River Lee, its relationship to the city and especially those parts of it not generally visible or appreciated. It is hoped that the guide will allow more people to use the River Lee for recreational purposes.

The first *CORKUMNAVIGATION* will take place on Tuesday 24th August, leaving Meitheal Mara, Proby's Quay at 3.30pm. Atlantic Sea Kayaking (atlanticseakayaking.com) will lead a fleet of curachs, kayaks, canoes and other small, shallow-draught boats in the inaugural *CORKUMNAVIGATION*.
